3. Hazards Identification

Main hazards: Highly flammable
Other hazards: In use, may form flammable/explosive vapour-air mixture

4. First Aid Measures

Skin contact: There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact. Wash with soap and water.
Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes.
Ingestion: There may be vomiting and nausea. Drink plenty of water to dilute chemicals. Seek medical advice.
Inhalation: There may be vomiting. Drowsiness may occur. Move the exposed person to the fresh air.

5. Fire Fighting Measures
