Contains: Aqua, Tetrasodium EDTA, Glycerin, Sodium Chloride, Sodium Palm Kernelate, CI 77891, Perfume, Sodium Tallowate, Tetrasodium Etidronate, Butylphenylmethylpropional.

3. Hazards Identification

Main hazards: Irritating to eyes.

4. First Aid Measures

Skin contact: Not applicable.
Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. Wash eye thoroughly with plenty of clean water.
